Straight Slide by Florida Leisure Kiddie (USAID #0104)

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Provide proper instructions, insure proper dispatching and guard pool area at end of slides.

OPERATING PROCEDURES:

Top of Slides

Always dispatch two riders simultaneously. If you have no line and send only one rider, be ready to communicate this to the guard at the bottom. If there is ever any uncertainty about a guest remaining in the slide blow two whistles and stop dispatch procedures immediately. Riders must start in a seated position, feet first, seated or on their back, and only one at a time. Riders are to be instructed to exit to the left if on left slide and to the right if on right slide, and to pick up their feet before entering the water. Hands and arms are to remain inside of slide at all times and at no time is anyone to stand or walk on slide. If rider stops on slide politely instruct them to stay seated and scoot until reaching the landing pool. You may walk down to the first hill and assist rider with a push over hill if needed. Before opening gates to release a rider make sure that the guard at the bottom has given the all clear signal, and that you have visually checked to make sure slide and pool is clear.

Bottom of Slides

Encourage the guest to exit to the appropriate quickly. Politely correct guest violating safety rules and do not permit anyone to cross over into other slide path. When guest has completely exited the pool and walked around pool behind fence, ring buzzer or give all clear signal to notify the top that the area is clear to dispatch. If only one rider exits into catch pool, communicate with guard at top and visually inspect slide before signaling again. If there is any uncertainty about a guest remaining in the slide blow two whistles and or call the top of the slide and stop dispatch procedures immediately.

SIGN RULES:

1. No double riding
2. Ride feet first, seated or on back only.
3. Do not stop, twist or swing body.
4. No eyeglasses without straps.
5. No T-Shirts or Denim shorts.
6. Lift feet before entering the water.
7. No Tubes allowed.
8. Keep hands and arms inside slide at all times.
9. Exit to the Left (left slide). Exit to the Right (right slide).
10. Catch pool is 4 ft. deep.
11. Do not ride if you have any physical or medical limitations.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Provide proper instructions, insure proper dispatching and watch run outs at end of slide.

OPERATING PROCEDURES:

Top of Slide

Always dispatch three riders simultaneously. If you have no line and send less than three riders, communicate this to the guard at the bottom. If there is ever any uncertainty about a guest remaining in the slide blow two whistles and stop dispatch procedures immediately. Riders are to start lying on their backs, feet first and one at a time. The guard is to instruct the rider to cross his/her legs and arms. Arms are to be crossed under the neck, with hands grasping the front side of the shoulder, elbows tucked in, this position is to be maintained throughout the ride. Before releasing a rider, make sure that the guard at the bottom has given a all clear signal. Riders cannot wear any type of mask.

Bottom of Slide

Encourage the guest to exit the runout quickly. Politely correct guest violating safety rules and do not permit anyone to cross over runouts, they are to exit to the gate closest to the slide they rode. When the area inside of gates is clear, give OK signal to notify guard at the top that the area is clear to dispatch. If less than three riders enter the runout area, communicate with the guard at the top how many people were sent, before signaling again. If there is any uncertainty about a guest remaining in the slide blow two whistles and stop dispatch procedures immediately.

SIGN RULES:

1. No double riding
2. Ride feet first, lying flat on back, cross arms on chest and cross legs, maintain this position until ride ends.
3. Do not stop, twist or swing body.
4. No eyeglasses.
5. Do not attempt to slow down or sit up while riding.
6. No T-Shirts. No Denim Material.
7. This attraction is not recommended for 5 yrs. and under.

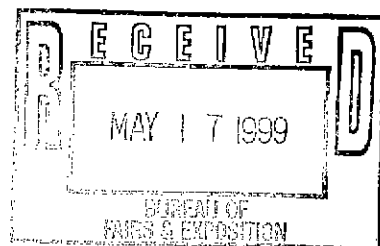
Dear Michael W. Rinehart,

Your company was inspected on the above date and during that inspection your representative produced the required information but did not provide the department with a copy.

We have not received the requested information and again request that you provide it to us promptly otherwise you may not be able to continue operating this ride in Florida and the annual permit may be rescinded.
