OPERATING PROCEDURES FOR GIANT SLIDE



- A. Meet with ride employees to go over the procedures that they are to use to do a safety inspection of the slide on a daily basis. Employees are to check the following:

Check the stairway, fencing, sliding surface, side panels, electrical, signage, carpeting, structural support and report back slide manager, if repairs are needed to be done they will be completed prior to opening.

- B. Explain to each individual employee what their duties are for the day depending upon their position with the slide. Duties are as follows:

The top platform position responsibilities are to assist patrons in the proper manner in which to slide. These procedures are as follows: lay mat down in an open lane, to sit up on mat in an erect position, do not let hands or feet touch the slide by keeping them on the mat, when they get to the bottom to get up quickly for someone may be sliding behind them, assisting parents with children and double riders to make sure they are positioned in an order from large to small, seated flat on the mat between one another's legs.

- C. The Bottom Carpeted Landing Area: This individual's duties would be to assist double riders in getting up, to make sure people get up quickly if someone is sliding behind them, pick up any mats that would be left by patrons and return the mats to the box where mats are kept. Also remove any foreign objects that may be the property of the riders or any trash. Assist prospective customers in any questions they may have in sliding while keeping a constant vigilance on the slide.
- D. Ticket Taker: Job responsibilities would be to take the proper amount of tickets that are required for the slide, to monitor age restrictions to be sure the younger children are accompanied by an adult and that infants are not allowed, infants being 2 years of age and under. To maintain order and discipline in the walkways and stairs.

E. Supervisor's Responsibilities: To insure that all employees are doing the proper job at their designated position, to make decisions regarding weather, i.e., wind, rain or moisture to insure riders safety. To monitor patrons to check for any minor injuries, and if such injuries occur, fill out proper forms and direct to first aid. If major injuries occur, summons first aid immediately and notify Midway office. Also, notify ride safety inspectors. After proper procedure notification, supervisor will inspect slide surface to insure there are no foreign objects, skin too slick or too much moisture. After this situation has been taken care of, the proper safety checks have been completed, the Supervisor will determine when and if the ride can be re-opened.

All employees are cross trained except for the management position to insure they are famaliar with the responsibilities of each position.
