WALK THROUGH SAFETY CHECK LIST

- 1) Check that all of the motors are equipped with propeller guards and that they are secure.
- 2) Make sure that the motors are secured to the floor of the boats, by all four (4) nuts, at the metal base plate.
- 3) Check the metal base plate on the motor for fatigue cracks, where it attaches to the floor.
4. Check that each light standard is properly grounded through the light cord.
- 5) The metal structure of the ride and light circuits must be grounded back through the generator.
- 6) Make sure that at least two (2) fire extinguishers are provided on the ride. (Minimum rating of 10-B:C)
- 7) Fire extinguishers should be located at the back of the ride and at the front control console.
- 8) Check that "NO SMOKING" signs are posted in conspicuous areas on the ride.
- 9) Check that the metal safety containers for gasoline, have a flash back arrestor in the pouring spout.
- 10) Check that the ride is provided with at least two (2) rescue flotation devices.
- 11) Check that the blunt ends of the bolts and R keys do not project from jack stands and ride base. Protrusion could cause injury to passing midway guests
- 12) Check that the three (3) safety cables are in position around the perimeter of the tank.

SAFE OPERATING PROCEDURES

- 1) No food, drink or smoking allowed on the ride.
- 2) Guests must leave all hand carried items behind before entering the ride.

BUMPER BOATS (continued)

- 3) The ride is designed to accommodate guests who are 42" in height or taller.
- 4) Assist the guests into the boat seats and make sure that they are properly seated
- 5) The boats are restricted to one guest per seat.
- 6) Running on the deck is not permitted when guests enter or exit the ride.
- 7) Before releasing the boats from the deck, make sure that all guests are properly seated.
- 8) Make sure that the entrance and exit gates are closed to prevent anyone from entering while the ride is in motion.
- 9) Guests must remain in their seats while the ride is in operation.
- 10) Monitor the ride during operation for any unsafe activity. If detected, dock the boat and take appropriate action.
- 11) During refueling operations, the ride shall be shut down and the deck cleared of Guests.
- 12) The refueling operations are not to take place on any side of the ride where midway guests will be exposed.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

- 1) In the event of severe weather such as high winds & lightning:
 - a) Dock all boats.
 - b) Assist the guests off of the ride in a safe and orderly manner.
- 2) In the event of a power failure during evening hours, where visibility is greatly reduced:
 - a) Follow the procedure outlined in item 1 above.
- 3) In the event of an incident:
 - a) Do not let anyone else on the ride.

BUMPER BOATS (continued)

- b) Dock all boats and evacuate guests from the ride in a safe and orderly manner.
 - c) Attend to the injured guest, make them comfortable but do not move them unless necessary.
 - d) Notify proper office personnel, supervision, first aid, etc.
- 4) In the event that a guest falls overboard:
- a) Perform a water rescue immediately using the flotation device.
 - b) Perform C P R, if necessary.
 - c) Follow the procedure outlined in item 3 above.

GUIDE FOR DISABLED GUESTS

- 1) Guests must be able to sit upright and have good physical agility and upper body strength.
- 2) Guests must be able to ride alone.
- 3) Ride entry is very difficult.
- 4) Height restriction - guest must be 42" or taller.
